Board and Management

As stated at the AGM, the Board of Directors wants to realign its relationship with Management to a model more typical of most condominiums. In this model, the Board sets policies and procedures, approves spending, delegates responsibilities, receives reports, makes decisions, and directs management. Management, for its part recommends actions, implements policy and procedures, enforces rules, obtains quotes, prepares analysis, and manages day-to-day issues and activities. In practical terms, this means that Board members will be minimizing their involvement in the hands-on management of the property. For example: Delivering guest suite FOB on weekends or putting the elevator in-service for deliveries. We understand that Residents may be accustomed to Board members being actively and directly involved in the management of the property; however, it is not the place of Board members to take on duties and responsibilities of the Property Manager or Superintendent.

The Board understands that this will be an adjustment from some residents as we transition to the new model, and we ask your patience as you get used to relying more on Management.

For their part, Members of the Board are happy to engage in discussions around visions for our condominium community and how these might drive policy and procedures. And, having said that, a reminder . . .
